

Portrait of Napoleon Bonaparte was a gift to the library from Emma Flower Taylor in 1907. This painting is a copy of the famous Paul De La Roche's painting which stands in Luxembourg Palace.

This painting appropriately hangs in the Napoleon Room which is located on the main floor in the south corridor.

A Holland Dame by Robert David Gauley 1875-1943 is located on the upper level of the library. This painting was the winner of the 1906 City Art Show in Watertown.

The Tramp by Eastman Johnson is located on the main level of the library in the South Reading Room also known as the Green Room.

This painting was given to the library by Emma Flower Taylor in 1912. The painting depicts a tramp at a farmhouse door looking for a handout with the family looking through the door at him.
